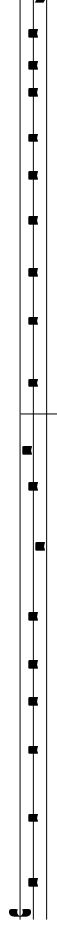
WHY standest thou so far off, O Lord: and hidest thy face in the needful time



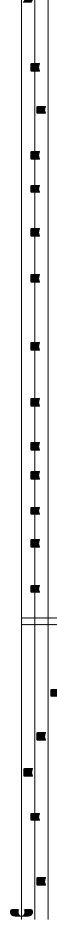
of trouble? 2. The ungodly for his own lust doth persecute the poor: let them



be taken in the crafty wiliness that they have i-magined. 3. For the ungodly



hath made boast of his own heart's desire: and speaketh good of the covetous,



whom God ab-horreth. 4. The ungod-ly is so proud, that he careth not for



God: neither is God in all his thoughts.⁵ His ways are always grievous: thy



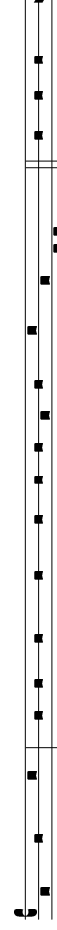
judgements are far a-bove out of his sight, and therefore defi-eth he all his



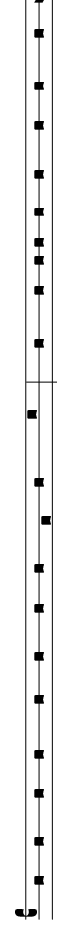
ene-mies. 6. For he hath said in his heart, Tush, I shall never be cast



down: there shall no harm happen unto me. 7. His mouth is full of cursing, de-



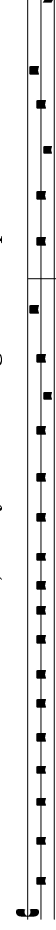
ceit, and fraud: under his tongue is ungod-liness and van-ity. 8. He sitteth



lurking in the thievish corners of the streets: and privily in his lurking dens



doth he murder the innocent; his eyes are set against the poor. 9. For he lieth



waiting secretly, even as a li-on lurketh he in his den: that he may ravish

6 the poor. 10. He doth ravish the poor: when he getteth him into his net.

6 11. He falleth down, and humbleth himself: that the congregation of the poor
6 may fall into the hands of his captains. 12. He hath said in his heart, Tush,

6 God hath forgotten: he hideth away his face, and he will never see it.

6 13. Arise, O Lord God, and lift up thine hand: forget not the poor. 14. Wherefore

6 should the wicked blaspheme God: while he doth say in his heart, Tush, thou
6 God carest not for it. 15. Surely thou hast seen it: for thou be-holdest

6 ungod-liness and wrong. 16. That thou mayest take the matter in - to thy

6 hand: the poor committeth himself un-to thee; for thou art the helper of the
6 friendless. 17. Break thou the power of the ungodly and malicious: take away

6 his ungodliness, and thou shalt find none. 18. The Lord is King for ever and
6 ever-: and the heathen are perished out of the land. 19. Lord, thou hast heard

6 the desire of the poor: thou preparest their heart, and thine ear hearken-eth

6 thereto; 20. To help the fatherless and poor unto their right: that the man

6 of the earth be no more exalted against them. Glory be to the Father, and

6 to the Son: and to the Ho-ly Ghost; As it was in the beginning, is now,

6 and ever shall be: world without end. Amen
