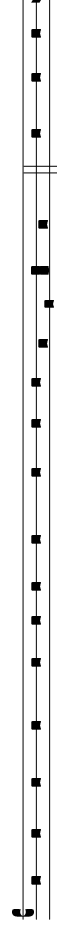
UNTO thee, O Lord, will I lift up my soul; my God, I have put my trust in thee:



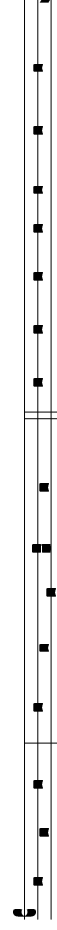
O let me not be confounded, neither let mine enemies triumph



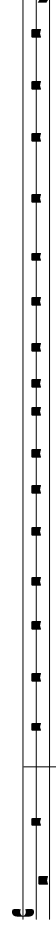

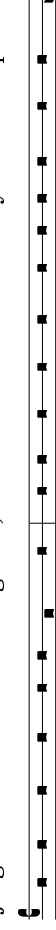
me, O Lord, for thy goodness. 7. Gracious and righteous is the Lord: therefore



will he teach sinners in the way. 8. Them that are meek shall he guide in



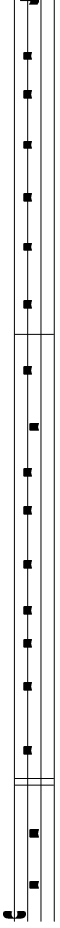
judgement: and such as are gentle, them shall he learn his way. 9. All the paths



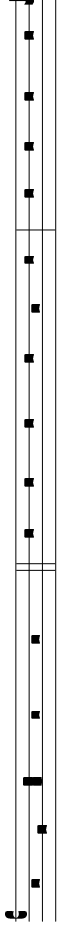
of the Lord are mercy and truth: un-to such as keep his co-venant and his



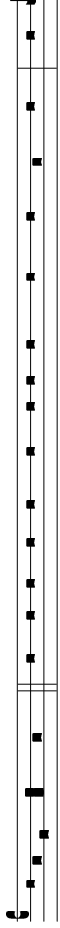
testimonies.10. For thy Name's sake, O Lord: be merciful unto my sin, for it



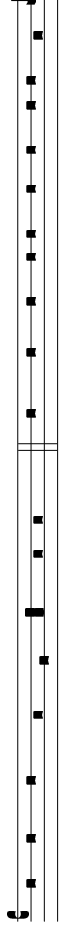
is great.11. What man is he that feareth the Lord: him shall he teach in the



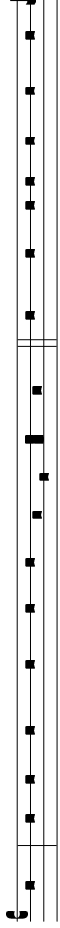
way that he shall choose. 12. His soul shall dwell at ease: and his seed shall



inherit the land.13. The secret of the Lord is among them that fear him: and



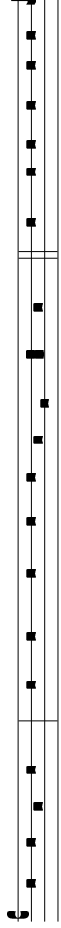
he will shew them his cov - enant. 14. Mine eyes are ever looking unto the



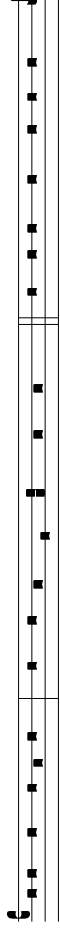
Lord: for he shall pluck my feet out of the net.15. Turn thee unto me, and have



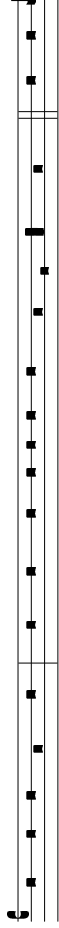
mercy upon me: for I am desolate and in mi-sery. 16. The sorrows of my heart



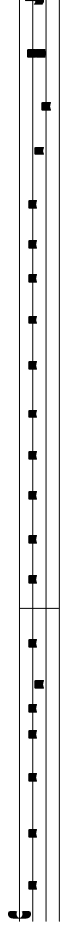
are enlarged: O bring thou me out of my troubles.17. Look upon my adver-



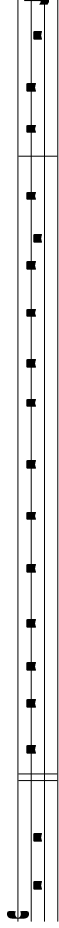
sity and misery: and forgive me all my sin. 18. Consider mine en-emies,

my soul, and deliver me: let me not be confounded, for I have put my trust



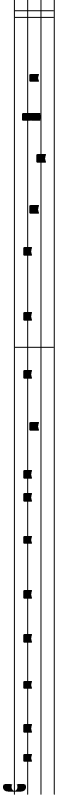
in thee. 20. Let perfectness and righteous dealing wait upon me: for my hope
