





THOU, O God, art praised in Sion: and unto thee shall the vow be performed

come. 3. My misdeeds prevail against me: O be thou merci-ful un-to




our sins. 4. Blessed is the man whom thou choolest, and receiv-est un-to




thee: he shall dwell in thy court, and shall be satis-fied with the pleasures
