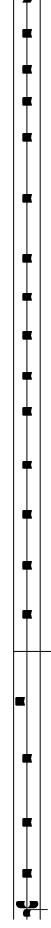

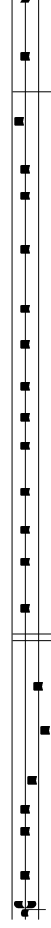
I WILL cry un-to God with my voice: ev-en un-to God will I cry with



my voice, and he shall hearken un-to me. 2. In the time of my trouble



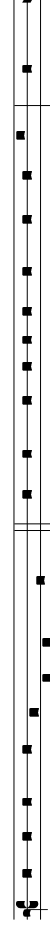

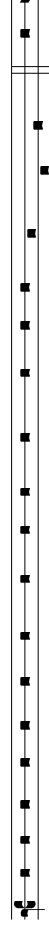
his mercy clean gone for ever: and is his promise come utterly to an end

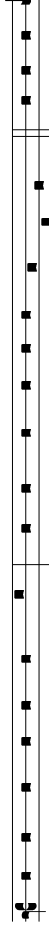
voice of thy thunder was heard round about: the lightnings shone upon the



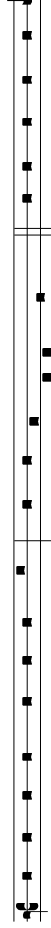
ground; \*the earth was moved, and shook withal. 19. Thy way is in the sea, and



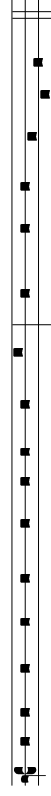
thy paths in the great waters: and thy footsteps are not known. 20. Thou
