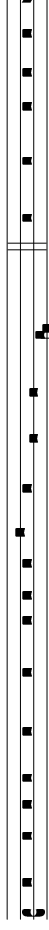

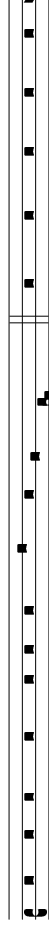
O GOD, the heathen are come into thine inheritance: thy ho-ly temple have



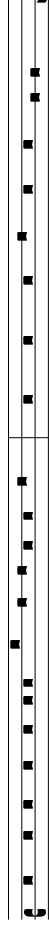
they de-filed, and made Jeru-salem an heap of stones. 2. The dead bodies of



thy servants have they given to be meat un-to the fowls of the air: and the



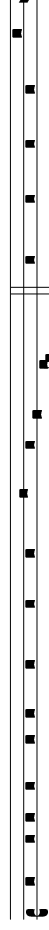
flesh of thy saints un-to the beasts of the land. 3. Their blood have they shed



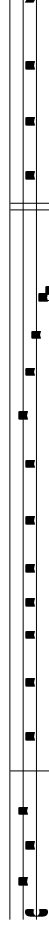
like water on ev-ery side of Jeru-salem: and there was no man to bury



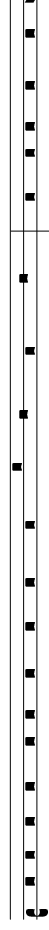
them. 4. We are become an open shame to our en-emies: a very scorn

be angry: shall thy jealou-sy burn like fire for ev-er? 6. Pour out thine



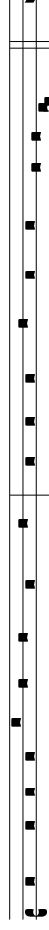
indignation upon the heathen that have not known thee: and upon the king-

have mercy up-on us, and that soon: for we are come to great miser-y.



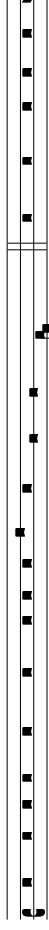
