Deus, quis similis?



us root them out, that they be no more a people: and that the name of Is-



rael may be no more in remembrance. 5. For they have cast their heads togeth-




er with one consent: and are confeder-ate against thee; 6. The ta-berna-cles

9. But do thou to them as unto the Madianites: unto Sise-ra, and unto Jabin



at the brook of Kison; 10. Who perished at Endor: and became as the dung



of the earth.11. Make them and their princes like Oreb and Zeb: yea, make

all their princes like as Zeba and Salmana; 12. Who say, Let us take to
ourselves: the houses of God in possession. 13. O my God, make them like
unto a wheel: and as the stubble before the wind; 14. Like as the fire that
burneth up the wood: and as the flame that consumeth the mountains.
15. Persecute them ev-en so with thy tempest: and make them a-fraid with
thy storm. 16. Make their faces a-shamed, O Lord: that they may seek thy
Name. 17. Let them be confounded and vexed ever more and more: let them be
put to shame, and perish. 18. And they shall know that thou, whose Name
is Je-hovah: art only the most Highest over all the earth. Glory be to
the Father, and to the Son: and to the Ho-ly Ghost; As it was in the
