


Psalm 118

*Confitemini Domino*

O GIVE thanks un-to the Lord, for he is gracious: because his mer-cy  
 endureth for ever. 2. Let Isra-el now confess that he is gracious: and  
 that his mercy endureth for ever. 3. Let the house of Aaron now confess:  
 that his mercy endureth for ev-er. 4. Yea, let them now that fear the Lord  
 confess: that his mercy endureth for ever. 5. I called upon the Lord in trou-  
 ble: and the Lord heard me at large. 6. The Lord is on my side: I will  
 not fear what man doeth unto me. 7. The Lord taketh my part with them that  
 help me: therefore shall I see my de-sire up-on mine en-emies. 8. It  
 is better to trust in the Lord: than to put any confidence in man. 9. It is  
 better to trust in the Lord: than to put a-ny con-fidence in princes.  
 10. All nations compassed me round a-bout: but in the Name of the Lord will I  
 des-troy them. 11. They kept me in on ev-ery side, they kept me in, I say, on  
 ev'ry side: but in the Name of the Lord will I des-troy them. 12. They came



a-bout me like bees, and are extinct even as the fire among the thorns: for  
in the Name of the Lord I will des-troy them.<sup>13</sup> Thou hast thrust sore at me,  
that I might fall: but the Lord was my help.<sup>14</sup> The Lord is my strength, and  
my song: and is become my sal-vation.<sup>15</sup> The voice of joy and health is in the  
dwellings of the righteous: the right hand of the Lord bringeth mighty things  
to pass. <sup>16</sup> The right hand of the Lord hath the pre- eminence: the right hand  
of the Lord bringeth mighty things to pass. <sup>17</sup> I shall not die, but live: and  
declare the works of the Lord. <sup>18</sup> The Lord hath chasten-ed and corrected  
me: but he hath not given me over unto death<sup>19</sup>. Open me the gates of right-  
eousness: that I may go into them, and give thanks unto the Lord<sup>20</sup>. This is  
the gate of the Lord: the righteous shall enter in-to it. <sup>21</sup> I will thank thee,  
for thou hast heard me: and art become my sal - vation. <sup>22</sup> The same stone  
which the builders re-fused: is become the head- stone in the corner.<sup>23</sup> This

is the Lord's doing: and it is marvellous in our eyes.<sup>24</sup> This is the day which  
the Lord hath made: we will rejoice and be glad in it. <sup>25</sup> Help me now, O  
Lord: O Lord, send us now prosper-ity. <sup>26</sup> Blessed be he that cometh in the  
Name of the Lord: we have wished you good luck, ye that are of the house of  
the Lord.<sup>27</sup> God is the Lord who hath shewed us light: bind the sac-rifice with  
cords, yea, even unto the horns of the altar. <sup>28</sup> Thou art my God, and I will  
thank thee: thou art my God, and I will praise thee.<sup>29</sup> O give thanks unto the  
Lord, for he is gracious: and his mercy endureth for ever. Glory be to the  
Father, and to the Son: and to the Holy Ghost; As it was in the beginning,  
is now, and ever shall be: world without end. Amen
