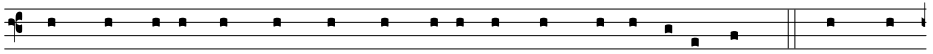
UNTO thee lift I up mine eyes: O thou that dwellest in the heavens.



2. Behold, even as the eyes of servants look un-to the hand of their masters,



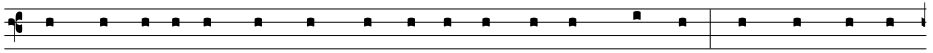
*and as the eyes of a maiden un-to the hand of her mistress: even so our



eyes wait upon the Lord our God, until he have mercy upon us. 3. Have mer-



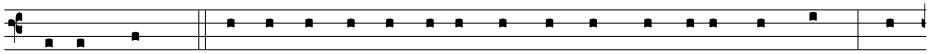
cy upon us, O Lord, have mercy upon us: for we are utterly despised.
